

**SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL**  
**(Church Road, Oldbury-on-Severn) (Temporary Prohibition of use by Vehicles,  
Pedestrians, Pedal Cycles and Equestrians) Order 2019**

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended have made an order the effect of which has closed, temporarily, to vehicles, pedestrians, pedal cycles and equestrians that length of Church Road which extends from a point 390 metres north east of its junction with Manor Farm Lane in a north easterly direction for a distance of 600 metres.

This order was required in connection with the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon drainage works on or adjacent to the highway and became operative from the 22 July 2019 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to be of **10 weeks** duration.

**Alternative routes:**

Vehicles - Church Road, Kington Lane, Castle Street, Gloucester Road, Butt Lane, Oldbury Lane, Pickedmoor Lane, Chapel Road and vice versa.

Pedestrians – Footpaths OOS/59/10, OOS/60/10 and vice versa. Equestrians OOS/56/40
