

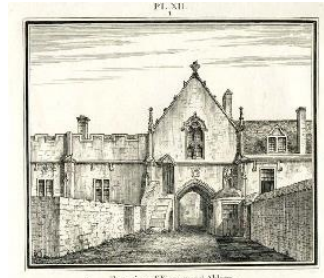
Oldbury on Severn Village History Group- 2016/17
