Meetings and decision making

Normal council & committee meetings are suspended for the time being. Councillors and the Clerk are making every effort to continue running the council as normally as possible in the face of the current restrictions and government advice. This means that some decisions normally made in public may need to be made via email discussions or other online technology. We regret that this means there is a consequent lack of transparency, but hope that parishioners will understand that this is unavoidable in the situation.

All such decisions will be recorded, and this list will be presented to the next full meeting of the council held in public, whenever that might be.

Playing Fields & Pavilion

The Pavilion and the multi-use games area are closed to all users. The car park will remain locked.

Whilst we cannot physically close the children's play area, we ask potential users to note that the area is not cleaned at all and there is a potential for transmission of infections via the equipment. **Anyone who chooses to use the play area at this time is requested to follow all current hygiene and social distancing advice.**

Dog waste

The council are aware that there has been an increase in the number of dog walkers in the area and that waste facilities have been overwhelmed. We are seeking additional help from South Glos council Streetcare department to improve the situation.
